## HOLIDAY LIGHTING

A reasonable amount of outside electrical holiday decorations can be displayed **30 days prior to the holiday and removed within 2 weeks after the holiday**. Holiday exterior lighting should only be **used during the evening period between 6pm—11pm**. Rooftop decorations are prohibited. Decoration materials must be fire resistant. **Nails, spikes, building staples, or any other type of fastener that leaves permanent damage are prohibited.**

- Residents may use clips or tape to install holiday lighting.
- Residents will carefully inspect and control ornamental lighting to avoid fire.
- Outside light and electrical cords must be designated for outdoor use.



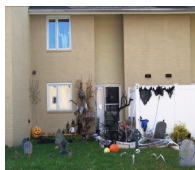


## SEASONAL DECORATING CONTEST

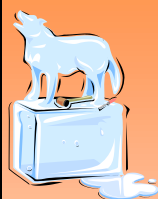

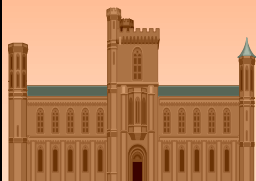

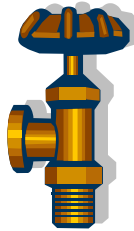


# Maintenance Messages

- Hose bibs** - With the cold temperatures around the corner, remember to remove your hoses from the bibs and turn off the water to the outdoor faucets. If you are unable to turn off the water, insulate the bib with an insulator.



- Shut Off Valves** - Be sure to know where your home's shut-off valves are located in case of an emergency. Knowing the locations of your shut-off valves can help prevent a disaster from occurring in your home.



If you are not aware of your shut-off locations, contact maintenance to have a service technician locate and demonstrate the proper way to shut off your valves in the case of an emergency.
