## Seasonal Decorating Contest

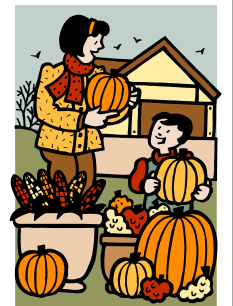


*Gather all your seasonal decorations and put your imagination to work!*
